Latter-day Prophets










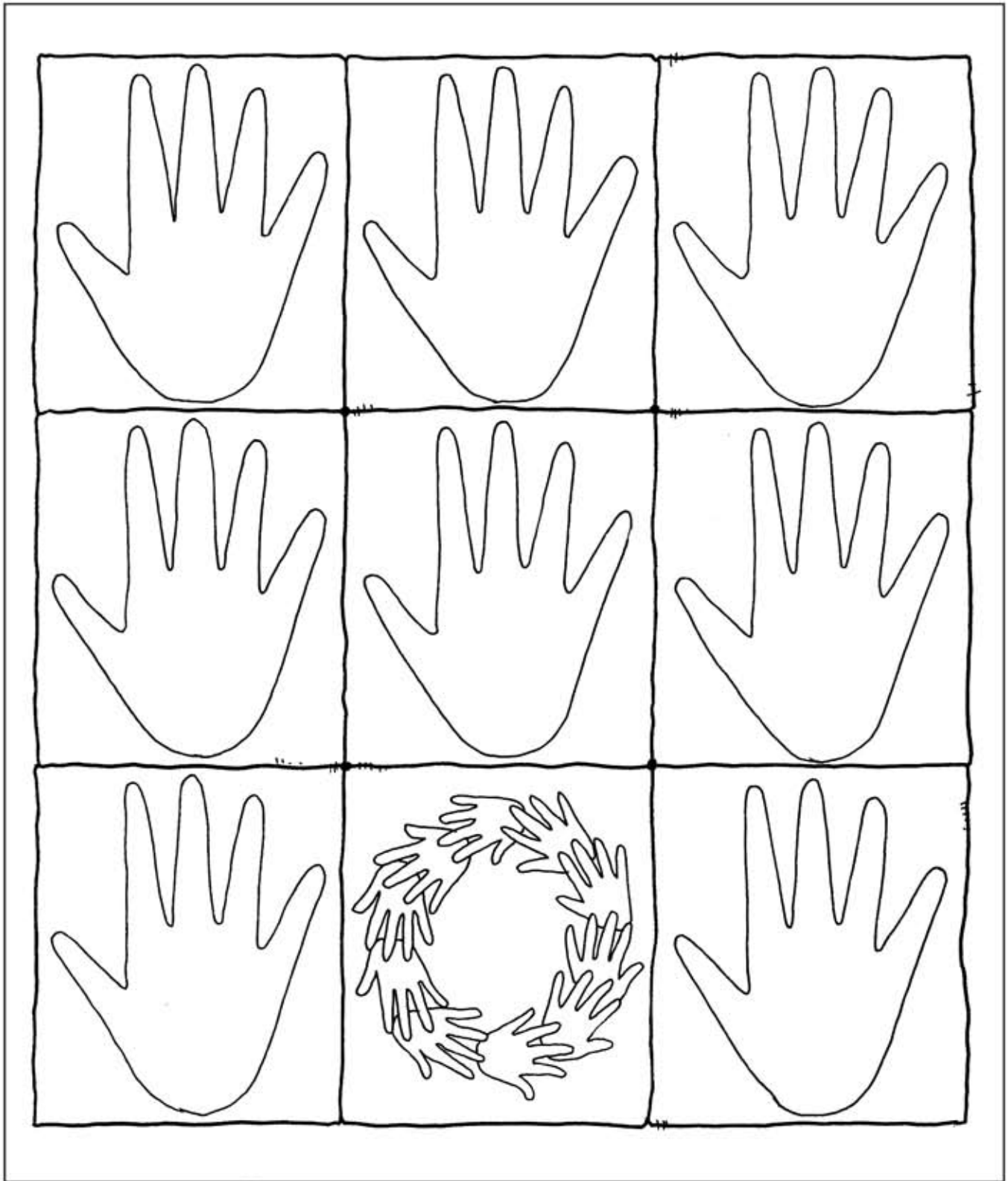
Tally Up
